The Founder's Award Scholarship is for a Graduating African American [JROTC] Junior Reserve Officer Training Cadet in the Montgomery County /K Christian County School Systems entering a Two to Four Year Accredited College or University ROTC Program, having an Earned GPA of 3.2. The Candidate must have demonstrated Overall Positive Attitude in Leadership, Possessing a Role Model Character in either Academics, Community Service, and Human Relationship. The Award is meant to Foster and Support Team-Play and Uplift the Candidate's Commitment for becoming a Positive Leader in a Multicultural World and to further espouse an Attitude of Fair Play: Family Values, Justice, Moral Fiber, and keeping Alive the Positive Contributions of African American Heroes in Peacetime and War, while reflecting heavily upon Buffalo Soldier's Military Contributions, History 1866-1890's and beyond to 1944.

5. The Scholarship Award will be Presented at the 5th Annual Black Tie Ball, at the Quality INN, off I-24, Clarksville, Tn., the Award Recipient and Parents will be a Honored Guest at the Annual Black Tie Ball.
