

MICKEY FISHER MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

The Mickey Fisher Memorial Scholarship Board will award one scholarship per school year to a graduating senior who meets the qualifications and plans to enroll at Austin Peay State University. Applicants will be students of Ft. Campbell High School and other surrounding high schools who are children of Ft. Campbell soldiers who are serving or have served our country on the battlefield. If, in a given year there are no students in this category, next priority would go to a graduate who most closely fits the qualifications established by the Mickey Fisher Memorial Scholarship Committee.

The scholarship will be based on academic achievement and extracurricular and community involvement - not financial need. The scholarship may be used for tuition, room, board and/or fees charged by Austin Peay State University.

The scholarship is renewable and the recipient may apply each year provided a grade point average of 3.0 is maintained.

Eligibility Requirements and Procedures

- 1. The applicant must be a high school senior who will complete requirements for graduation between January and June of the current school year.**
- 2. The applicant is to attend Austin Peay State University during the coming academic year.**
- 3. The Scholarship Applicant Profile (use attached form) must be included with the application. The profile should be from one of your high school teachers or from a person of your choice, not related to you.**
- 4. Attach an official sealed transcript of your grades covering the first seven semesters of high school. Include your ACT or SAT scores.**
- 5. DO NOT put your name on pages 2 and 3, the essay page, or any attached pages.**
- 6. INCOMPLETE APPLICATIONS will be disqualified. It is your responsibility to ensure that the application is complete and on time.**
- 7. Questions about eligibility or requirements may be directed to your guidance counselor.**
- 8. Completed applications must be returned to the guidance office on or before April 6.**
